Medium to full-bodied, the wine is rich with a round edge and energetic acidity and displays a balanced structure across the mid-palate. The wine shows delightful complexity on the lingering finish with lasting sensations of citrus blossom, Anjou pear and peach skin followed by a nuance of graham cracker crust. Nicely done.

Displaying with a deep ruby core with purple highlights, the 2016 Cabernet Sauvignon Heather Hill has a robust and generous nose, offering up plum reduction, blackberries and a smooth chocolaty essence before swaying toward a cherry compote expression with a soft herbal nature and a hint of bell pepper. Full-bodied, the mid-palate shows a velvety mouthfeel and balanced structure that presides with luscious black fruit purée flavors in the mouth. Finishing long and drawn out, flavors of juicy plum, blackberry with hints of sage and dark chocolate linger on the palate, proving without a doubt that this is the best bottling of the range. It's delicious.
