

2014 Cabernet Sauvignon Columbia Valley

93 Points - Vinous 'Ripe aromas of currant, black cherry, licorice, fresh herbs and dark chocolate, lifted by a floral element. Plush and seamless but laid-back, conveying restrained sweetness to its creamy flavors of currant, mocha and licorice. A very suave Cab. Excellent aging potential."

92 Points - Wine Advocate "An attractive wine, revealing notes of cassis,

blackberries, rich soil, espresso roast and a judicious framing of new oak. On the palate, it's mediumbodied and nicely balanced, with good depth at the core, fine structuring tannins and a long, savory finish. In fact, I suspect it may prove longer lived than the flashier Heather Hill from Walla Walla."
