94+ Points - Vinous "Alluring aromas of blackberry, pomegranate, cassis, bitter chocolate, menthol, lavender and mint. Wonderfully broad, rich and dry; at once mouthfilling and clearly delineated. This fleshy, glossy wine conveys insidious sweetness to its dark berry fruit. Finishes with substantial building tannins, a wisp of tobacco, and slowly mounting floral lift..."
