

2017 Cabernet Sauvignon Heather Hill Estate Walla Walla Valley

93 Points - Vinous "More precise and alive on the nose than Abeja's other 2017 Cabernet, offering aromas of currant, leather, licorice, dark chocolate, loam and tobacco leaf; conveys a strong impression of place. Suave and fine-grained on entry, then sweet, silky and intense in the middle palate, with plum, currant and milk chocolate flavors sharing the ripeness of the Walla Walla Cabernet but showing more refinement and lift. Wonderfully silky and suave, with excellent concentration, texture and weight. The slowly mounting, palate-saturating back end features wellbuffered, building tannins. Much firmer than the CV Cabernet but without any rough edges."
