VINTAGE OVERVIEW

After a slow start to spring, the 2018 growing season warmed quickly with temperatures staying quite warm before moderating significantly in early September. Harvest conditions were ideal as the Columbia Valley settled into a pattern of warm days and cool nights that slowed ripening enough to allow the grapes to mature fully while retaining the fruit's acidity.
