Medium to full-bodied, the palate displays succulent acidity with fine-grained tannins that make my mouth water and have me craving chargrilled red steaks and chops. This beauty will continue to age gracefully and remain food friendly for years to come. Just under 8,000 bottles were produced. Nicely done!"
