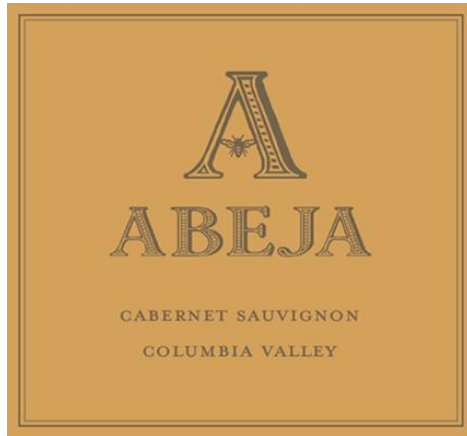


TOP AWARDS & REVIEWS



2014 Abeja Cabernet Sauvignon Columbia Valley

93 Points - Vinous “Ripe aromas of currant, black cherry, licorice, fresh herbs and dark chocolate, lifted by a floral element. Plush and seamless but laid-back, conveying a restrained sweetness to its creamy flavors of currant, mocha and licorice. This wine didn't display quite the sweetness, horizontality or length of the 2015 Merlot on first pour but it expanded beautifully with 48 hours without losing its spring. A very suave Cabernet with excellent aging potential.”

93 Points - Jeb Dunnuck “The 2014 Cabernet Sauvignon is terrific. A blend of 94% Cabernet Sauvignon and 3% each of Merlot and Cabernet Franc, aged 18 months in French oak, it offers loads of blackcurrants, cassis, and spicy oak aromatics, full body, sweet, soft tannin, and a luscious, silky texture. With terrific purity of fruit and an already approachable style, drink it over the coming decade or more.

92 Points - Wine Advocate “An attractive wine, revealing notes of cassis, blackberries, rich soil, espresso roast and a judicious framing of new oak. On the palate, it's medium-bodied and nicely balanced, with good depth at the core, fine structuring tannins and a long, savory finish. In fact, I suspect it may prove longer lived than the flashier Heather Hill bottlings from the Walla Walla Valley.”

90 Points - Wine Enthusiast “Milk chocolate, roasted coffee bean, black cherry and generous barrel spice aromas lead to supple, well-balanced fruit and barrel flavors in this wine. It shows pleasing nuances.”
