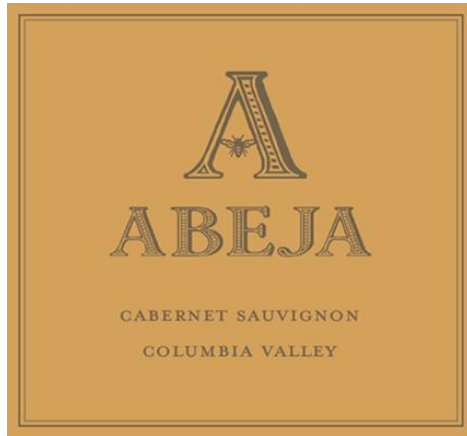

2015 Abeja Cabernet Sauvignon Columbia Valley

93 Points - Jeb Dunnuck “Deeply colored, the 2015 Cabernet Sauvignon spent 18 months in 70% new French oak. It has a brilliant bouquet of crème de cassis, toasted spice, graphite, and licorice. This gives way to a full-bodied Cabernet that has ripe, velvety tannins, beautiful mid-palate depth, and a great finish.”

92 Points - James Suckling “A firm and silky red with blackberries, blueberries and hints of chocolate that follow through to a medium body. Fine tannins and a delicious finish. Focused and pretty. Give it a year or two more.”

91+ Points - Vinous “Dark, bright medium ruby. Classic varietal aromas of cassis, black cherry, violet and licorice are accented by notes of crushed rock and orange zest. Juicy but still tightly wound; perhaps a bit oakier than it should be and thus the flavors of dark berries, spices and orange zest are showing a touch of leanness today. Finishes with a serious dusting of tannins and very good length.”

90 Points - Wine Spectator “Dense and well-structured, with brawny black cherry, smoked spice and anise flavors that take on power toward broad-shouldered tannins. Best from 2021 through 2025.”
